#### A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Michael McElligott called to order the Regular Board Meeting of the Palm Beach Plantation Community Development District on November 14, 2018, at 4:02 p.m. in the Palm Beach Plantation Clubhouse located at 8751 Palm Beach Plantation Boulevard, Royal Palm Beach, Florida 33411.

#### B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. McElligott presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on November 5, 2018, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Regular Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

#### C. SEAT NEW BOARD MEMBERS

The first item of business was to seat new Board Members. Mr. Nalty won the election for Seat # 1, and Mr. Warnet won the election for Seat # 3. The next item of business was to appoint a Board Member to fill Seat # 5. This was necessary because Mr. Mupo, the previous seat holder, did not qualify to run for re-election and thus, the seat becomes vacant as of November 20, 2018.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Feltz, seconded by Mr. Nalty, and unanimously passed declaring a vacancy for Seat #5, effective November 20, 2018.

## D. ADMINISTER OATH OF OFFICE & REVIEW BOARD MEMBER RESPONSBILITIES AND DUTIES

Thereafter, Michael McElligott swore in both Mr. Nalty and Mr. Feltz to start their new 4-year terms.

#### E. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Present and constituting a quorum were Russell Warnet, Dominick Mupo, William Nalty and Richard Feltz.

Staff in attendance were District Managers Michael McElligott and Andrew Karmeris of Special District Services, Inc.; District Counsel Vanessa Steinerts of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.; and Matthew Kahn of Caulfield & Wheeler Inc.

#### F. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

A **motion** was made by Mr. Nalty, seconded by Mr. Mupo to nominate Russell Warnet as Board Chairman. That **motion** passed unanimously.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Nalty, seconded by Mr. Mupo to nominate Richard Feltz as Board Vice Chairman. That **motion** passed unanimously.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Nalty, seconded by Mr. Mupo to nominate Michael McElligott as Secretary and Treasurer. That **motion** passed unanimously.

Mr. McElligott recommended that all other Board Supervisors, which consists of Mr. Brackett, Mr. Nalty, and Mr. Mupo, be designated as Assistant Secretaries and there was a **motion** by Mr. Nalty and a second by Mr. Mupo to that fact. That motion passed unanimously.

#### G. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

#### H. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

#### I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. September 19, 2018, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. McElligott presented the minutes of the September 19, 2018, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any changes or corrections. Without comment, a **motion** was made by Mr. Nalty, seconded by Mr. Mupo that the minutes of the September 19, 2018, Regular Board Meeting be approved, as presented. That **motion** passed unanimously.

#### J. OLD BUSINESS

#### 1. Update Regarding Lake Bank Erosion at Lake 6 Project

Mr. McElligott informed the Board that he signed the notice to proceed. Matthew Kahn from Caulfield & Wheeler Inc. confirmed that the notice to proceed was received and the project was slated to begin on November 26, 2018. Mr. Kahn then informed the Board that the contractor has recommended a materials change that would result in a savings of approximately \$3,200. Mr. Warnet asked questions about the proposed substitute material's strength, longevity, and appearance in comparison to the originally approved material. Mr. Kahn responded to Mr. Warnet that the two materials are comparable in strength and longevity, but the substitute material would be more esthetically pleasing.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Feltz, seconded by Mr. Warnet, to authorize Caulfield & Wheeler Inc. to prepare and execute a change order, and to inform the contractor to move forward with the substitute material. That **motion** passed unanimously.

#### 2. Update Regarding Sink Hole Near Weir

Mr. McElligott reminded the Board of the situation. Mr. Mupo volunteered to inspect the sink hole in mid-December and report back to the Board.

#### K. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2018-05 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Amended Budget

Mr. McElligott presented Resolution No. 2018-05, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-05**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE PALM BEACH PLANTATION COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AUTHORIZING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED FINAL FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018 BUDGET ("AMENDED BUDGET"), PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 189, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mupo, seconded by Mr. Feltz to approve Resolution no. 2018-05 as presented. That **motion** passed unanimously.

The Regular Board Meeting was recessed at 4:27 p.m. and a meeting of the Auditor Selection Committee was opened.

#### L. AUDITOR SELECTION COMMITTEE

#### 1. Ranking of Proposals/Consider Selection of an Auditor

A **motion** was made by Mr. Mupo, seconded by Mr. Nalty, to accept staff's ranking of proposals as follows:

- 2. Nowlen, Holt & Miner
- 3. Carr, Riggs & Ingram

The Regular Board Meeting reconvened at 4:31 p.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Nalty, seconded by Mr. Mupo, to accept the Audit Committee recommendation, selecting Grau & Associates as the top ranked choice for auditor.

#### M. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

#### 1. Financial Report

Mr. McElligott presented the Financial Report in the meeting book and opened it up for any questions. There were no action required.

#### N. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Mupo commented that the CDD is doing a wonderful job of controlling the water levels.

#### O. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Mupo, seconded by Mr. Nalty to adjourn the Regular Board Meeting at 4:34 p.m. That **motion** passed unanimously.
