#### A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Michael McElligott called to order the Regular Board Meeting of the Palm Beach Plantation Community Development District on March 19, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. in the Palm Beach Plantation Clubhouse located at 8751 Palm Beach Plantation Boulevard, Royal Palm Beach, Florida 33411.

#### **B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

Mr. McElligott presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on September 30, 2024, as legally required.

#### C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Present and constituting a quorum were Russ Warnet, Rebecca Delgado, and Bob Vey.

Staff in attendance were District Managers Michael McElligott of Special District Services, Inc. and District Counsel Scott Cochran of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

#### D. CONSIDER BOARD VACANCIES AND APPOINTMENTS

Mr. McElligott noted that since no one qualified for the open seats in the general election this past November, it would be appropriate to consider vacancies and appointments. The seats that were up this past election were seats 2 and 4.

There was a **motion** by Mr. Vey, with a second from Mrs. Delgado, to declare seats 2 and 4 vacant, and to reappoint Mr. Richard Feltz back to Seat 2, and to leave Seat 4 vacant at this time. The **motion** passed **3-0**.

Mr. Cochran explained that currently Mr. Lyles in their office is the registered agent for the District, but that Mr. Lyles is in the process of retiring, so a new registered agent from their office needs to be designated. Mr. Pawelczyk is the senior CDD attorney in the office, so they are recommending the Board designate him as the registered agent. After some discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Vey, seconded by Mrs. Delgado, and **passed 3-0** to adopt Resolution No. 2025-02 as presented appointing Mr. Pawelczyk as the registered agent.

If any person decides to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at these meetings, such person will need a record of the proceedings and such person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made at his or her own expense and which record includes the testimony and evidence on which the appeal is based.
